

Children's Exhibits - 2010

Please note that a child is defined as 16 years and under for the Summer Show 2010.

A child is entitled to enter any of the classes specific to their age **AND** any of the Adult Sections too (but they must state their age on the entry form). This entitled them to be counted towards the RHS Junior Award of Merit in Classes from Sections 1,2,3 & 4.
